DISCUSSING POLL STRATEGY

Cong holds meeting of Central Gujarat leaders in Vadodara

THE GUJARAT Pradesh Congress Committee (GPCC) convened an executive meeting with leaders from Central Gujarat in Vadodara on Sunday, to discuss strategies for the upcoming assembly elections.

State party president Jagdish Thakor and state incharge Raghu Sharma were among the leaders who met at the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya auditorium on Ajwa Road.

Speaking to media persons, Raghu Sharma said, "The Congress is preparing to win 125 seats and form the government and have been holding zone wise meetings. We held a meeting in Saurashtra on May 19, we held a meeting in South Gujarat on May 20. Today, we are in Vadodara for the Central Gujarat zone and we will meet North Gujarat leaders in Mehsana on Monday... We have also started the Adivasi Satyagraha in Dahod recently."

The leaders also said that the party is focussing on 182 con-

situencies in the state individually and will hold booth meetings in all the seats to achieve the 125-seat target.

GPCC president Jagdish Thakor told reporters, "Right from polling agents and party workers, we are preparing a calendar of activities to strategise for the upcoming polls. We are going to raise issues that are directly affecting the people — inflation, unemployment and how people are affected... The party is planning a detailed campaign on important issues."

BULLDOZER HITS WALL

JCB driver booked day after man, child died in wall collapse

A DAY after a 25-year-old man and his two-year-old daughter were killed when a wall collapsed on them due to a push by a bulldozer engaged in construction work in the Gomtipur area of Ahmedabad, police on Sunday booked the bulldozer driver for culpable homicide amounting to murder.

According to police, around 3 pm, a wall in Salatnagar near Ambika Bridge of Gomtipur collapsed after a JCB machine took a reverse and hit the wall. Prakash Salat (25) and his daughter Seema (2), residents of Salatnagar, came under the impact as they were resting near the wall.

Police said the JCB machine was engaged in construction work at the Ambika bridge and was driven by Mukesh Solanki, an Ahmedabad-based contractor.

"Four of us, including my brother and his daughter, were

standing near Dasha Mata temple, leaning against the wall at the entry gate of Salatnagar when a JCB machine hit the wall after the driver reversed it in a negligent manner... The wall collapsed and Prakash and Seema came under the impact... they were taken to civil hospital where they were declared brought dead by doctors," said Dhirubhai Salat, elder brother of deceased, in his complaint to police.

Taking cognisance, police booked Solanki under IPC sections 304 for culpable homicide and 279 for rash driving.

Solanki has also filed a police complaint stating that he was assaulted and his vehicle was vandalised after the incident on Saturday afternoon.

"After I took a reverse, a portion of JCB bulldozer hit the wall near Ambika bridge. Later, four men came to my vehicle and started assaulting me," said Solanki in his complaint to Gomtipur police.

COVID COUNT

15 NEW COVID CASES; ACTIVE TALLY AT 188

Gujarat on Sunday reported 15 Covid-19 cases, which took its tally to 12,24,908, while the death toll remained unchanged at 10,944, a state health department official said. Vadodra accounted for nine of the new cases, followed by five in Ahmedabad and one case in Valsad.

Mauritian woman held in Kutch for overstaying

Rajkot: A Mauritian woman was held from Madhapar village in Kutch for allegedly overstaying and has been sent to the joint interrogation centre (JIC) in Bhuj, Kutch (West) police said.

According to police, the woman, identified as Deorani, 48, wife of Rushikesh Madhup and daughter of Ramdutt Jagu, is a citizen of Mauritius, and was detained late on May 19 after she was reported to the police by one Jashpalsinh Jadeja, a resident of Madhapar.

"According to primary information, the woman has been living in Madhapar for three months. She says that she has lost her passport. She has been detained and sent to the JIC for questioning," Jayesh Panchal, deputy superintendent of police of Bhuj division of Kutch (west) police told The Indian Express.

"I was on a pilgrimage with family when this woman pleaded for help saying she lost her passport... I brought her to Madhapar with us," said Jadeja, a building painter. Adding that he got in touch with the Mauritian consulate in Mumbai and the embassy in Delhi with the help of a local journalist, Jadeja said, "They all advised me to report the matter to local police. Accordingly, I reported her to Madhapar police." **ENS**

ACB nabs revenue official taking Rs 11 lakh bribe

THE GUJARAT Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) held a revenue department official accepting a bribe of Rs 11 lakh on Saturday evening in Sanand of Ahmedabad.

According to ACB officials, Jitendra Kumar Patel, sub-registrar (grade 3), sub-registrar office, Revenue Bhawan in Sanand, and his accomplice Momin Rasul, a private citizen, were detained by a team with Rs 11 lakh cash that Patel had demanded in exchange of approving the complainant's three applications.

"The complainant submit-

ted his three sets of documents at the sub-registrar office for verification, out of which two sets were returned to him in due process. The accused official had not returned the third set of documents and initially demanded a bribe of Rs 18 lakh from the complainant," said an ACB official.

"Later, the bribe amount was settled at Rs 11 lakh and then the complainant approached the ACB. The officials laid a trap and the accused official and his accomplice were held accepting the amount at their office Saturday evening. They were detained and booked under sections of the Prevention of Corruption (PC) Act," the official added.

19-yr-old held with 71 grams of MD drugs

Ahmedabad: The Ahmedabad Police's Detection of Crime Branch (DCB) arrested a 19-year-old man with 71 grams of mephedrone (MD) drugs in Vejalpur of Ahmedabad on Sunday.

According to police, Sohail Mansuri, a resident of Fatehwadi in Ahmedabad, was held by a DCB team near Al-Buruj tower on the Juhapura-Makarba 100 feet road in Ahmedabad, in possession of the narcotics.

"Acting on specific input, the accused man was held by a team and we confiscated 71.28 grams of MD drugs worth Rs 7 lakh from him," said a senior official of Ahmedabad DCB.

"He told us that he is himself a drug addict and also sells it to people in Fatehwadi, Juhapura and surroundings during the evening hours. He makes small zipper pouches of one gram MD each and sells them for Rs 2,000-2,500 each. We have booked the accused under sections of the NDPS Act and further probe is on," the official added. **ENS**

Woman booked for throwing puppy to death from 3rd floor

Bhavnagar: A woman was booked for allegedly killing a puppy by throwing it from the third floor of a residential building in Bhavnagar city in Gujarat, police said on Sunday.

According to police, Asha Lumba threw a stray puppy from the third floor of the residential building on Saturday, and it was found dead in the parking lot of the complex, a Nilambaug police station official said.

"An FIR was lodged against her under Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act and section 429 (mischief by killing or maiming cattle, etc.) of the Indian Penal Code on the complaint of a woman who runs an animal helpline," the official said.

"As per the complainant, she received a call at 11am Saturday informing about a dead puppy being found in the parking lot. Some residents said the accused used to argue with them over feeding the puppy and had even threatened to kill it," he added.

Lumba is yet to be arrested and further probe is on, the official said. **PTI**
