Daughter wants J&K admin to shift Mehbooba

Srinagar: Former Jammu & Kashmir chief minister Mehbooba Mufti's daughter has asked the administration to shift her mother, under detention at a guest house here for the last three months, to a place equipped to deal with the Valley's harsh winter.

The Centre will be responsible if anything happens to Mehbooba, the president of the PDP, Itija Mufti has written in a letter to the Srinagar deputy commissioner.

"I've repeatedly raised concerns about the well-being of my mother. I wrote to DC Srinagar a month ago to shift her someplace equipped for the harsh winter. If anything happens to her, the Indian government will be responsible," Itija said in a tweet on Tuesday using her mother's Twitter handle.

She also posted a picture of her hand-written letter to the deputy commissioner.

"As you are aware my

mother Ms Mehbooba Mufti, former CM J&K has been jailed since 5 August. A doctor recently ran multiple tests on her as she was not keeping well. As per those tests, her Vitamin D, hemoglobin and Calcium levels are low," Itija Mufti wrote.

She said Mehbooba Mufti should be shifted to another location more suitable for the harsh winter. "The accommodation she is currently lodged in is not equipped for Kashmir's harsh winters. Keeping in mind these points, I would like to request you to shift her to another location more suitable. I hope you will address this problem urgently," the PDP leader's daughter said.

Mehbooba is among the many political leaders, including erstwhile Jammu and Kashmir's former chief ministers Farooq Abdullah and his son Omar Abdullah, who have been under detention in Srinagar since August 5, the day the Centre announced the abrogation of Article 370 provisions and the decision to bifurcate the state into two union territories. ■

'Shutting phone, net in J&K illegal & unconstitutional'

Services Not Operational Even After 90 Days, SC Told

New Delhi: Notifications and orders shutting down mobile, landline and internet services in Jammu & Kashmir following the abrogation of provisions of Article 370 were "illegal and unconstitutional", the Supreme Court was told on Tuesday.

A bench headed by Justice N V Ramana was told that even after 90 days, communication services — data, internet, pre-paid mobiles and SMS — were not operational in the Kashmir Valley, affecting the working of the media.

Advocate Vrinda Grover, appearing for Executive Editor of Kashmir Times Anuradha Bhasin who has challenged the restrictions imposed in the Valley, said the state has the power to put reasonable restrictions on the rights conferred under Article 19 (protection of certain rights regarding freedom of speech) but it cannot ex-

tinguish the right itself. "There is absolute communications shutdown from August 4. It requires to be tested by this court. Yes, there can be reasonable restrictions on rights under Article 19 but the same cannot extinguish the right itself," she told the bench, also comprising Justices R Subhash Reddy and B R Gavai.

Grover argued that orders issued by the authorities were with regard to reduction of speed of 3G and 4G data but the internet service was totally shut down. "This order is illegal and unconstitutional," she said while referring to one

of the orders issued by the Inspector General of Police (IGP) of Kashmir zone. "There is complete non-application of mind while issuing these orders. These are bald orders," she said. She argued that the J&K administration has said in its affidavit that for national security and to prevent loss of life, certain measures were taken.

Grover said authorities have claimed that internet services could be misused by "anti national elements" but their own data shows that incident of terrorist violence has gone down. "Is their any proximate nexus between inter-

net and terrorist violence?", she said, adding that, "90 days are over now. The word 'temporary' will lose its meaning if the restrictions still continue".

Referring to the provisions of the Temporary Suspension of Telecom Services (Public Emergency or Public Safety) Rules, 2017 and Indian Telegraph Act, she said that restrictions could be imposed only for temporary period and it cannot be enforced for longer time.

She said the media has got protection under the Constitution and freedom of press can be curbed only through a reasoned and specific order.

"So, according to you, general order of prohibition does not apply in your case unless special orders with reasons are passed," the bench asked. Responding to the query, the lawyer while referring to the rules said, "Yes. There has to be order with specific reasons with regard to press". Grover also said that if the authorities had apprehension about misuse of internet services, then why the landline phone services were shut down. ■

Home minister reviews situation in J&K UT

New Delhi: Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Tuesday reviewed the security situation in Jammu & Kashmir; three months after the Centre abrogated special status of the erstwhile state and split it into two UTs.

This is the first meeting between Shah and top civil and police officials of the newly-created Union Territory of J&K. Chief secretary B V R Subrahmanyam and DGP Dilbag Singh

briefed Shah about the prevailing situation in the UT, especially after restrictions were lifted from mobile phone networks, official sources said.

However, it is not immediately known if the meeting discussed the possibility of releasing political leaders who are in detention since August 5, when the Centre had announced abrogation of Article 370 provisions that gave the erstwhile state special status. Those under detention include former CMs Farooq Abdullah, Omar Abdullah and Mehbooba Mufti. ■

Azad slams NDA over J&K handling

Hyderabad: Senior Congress leader Ghulam Nabi Azad on Tuesday slammed the BJP-led NDA government's handling of the J&K issue saying even now political leaders and MPs and media were not allowed to visit the newly created union territory.

Azad, a former CM of J&K, said even he could visit J&K only with the Supreme Court's permission, recalling his first visit after the Centre scrapped special status to it under Art 370. "This government has internationalised Kashmir issue, they don't allow their own MPs, media and NGOs and tell MPs of foreign countries to go. That too, right wing MPs," he told media. If someone still says that situation in J&K was alright, then "treatment is required" for such a person. ■

Kashmir-return labourers to get ₹50K

Kolkata: West Bengal chief minister Mamata Banerjee on Tuesday said her government will provide one-time assistance of Rs 50,000 to all 123 labourers who had to leave their jobs in Kashmir and return to the state.

The government would also make accommodation arrangements under its Banglar Bari scheme for those who do not own houses, she said. A total of 89 labourers, including five from Assam, arrived here on Monday from Kashmir by a special coach of Jammu Tawi Express arranged by the state government. The men, who had gone to the Valley to earn livelihood, had expressed their desire to return, in the wake of the recent killing of five labourers by terrorists.

"All 123 labourers who have returned home from Kashmir yesterday are

helpless with no jobs. We have decided to help them with a one-time financial assistance of Rs 50,000 so that they can restart their lives. I have spoken to the chief secretary and the finance secretary before taking this decision," the chief

minister said at the state secretariat.

The workers, mostly from Birbhum, Cooch Behar and Dakshin Dinajpur districts, were employed with plywood factories and apple orchards in the trouble-torn Valley. They drew salaries in the range of Rs 15,000 to Rs 20,000. The TMC supremo said she had directed district magistrates to help the children of the returnees with their education.

"Those who do not own a house will be provided one under Banglar Bari scheme. The families of these labourers are already getting rice at Rs 2 per kg," she maintained. On October 29, five labourers were shot dead by terrorists in Kulgam district of Kashmir. One worker, who sustained bullet injuries in the attack, is undergoing treatment at a Srinagar hospital. ■

No coercive action order not applicable to fresh incident: Centre to HC

New Delhi: The Centre rushed to the Delhi high court on Tuesday urging it that its order for no coercive action against advocates, passed on Sunday following the lawyers-police clash at Tis Hazari Courts Complex, should not be applicable on the subsequent incidents. A bench of Chief Justice D N Patel and Justice C Hari Shankar issued notice and sought response of the Bar Council of India, the apex body of lawyers, and several other bar associations of the national capital on the Centre's plea.

The central government, represented by Additional Solicitor General Maninder Acharya, has sought a clarification from the court that "the order dated November 3, 2019 is no impediment in taking any action in accordance with law to maintain law and order". The high court had directed that no coercive action would be taken against any lawyer on the basis of FIRs lodged with regard to the November 2 incident.

The Centre's plea assumes significance as after the court order, an on-duty policeman and a civilian were allegedly thrashed by advocates outside Saket Court on Monday and on Tuesday, two separate FIRs were lodged by the police in this regard. During the brief hearing on the application, the advocates representing various lawyers' bodies urged the high court to ban the media from showing videos of the recent incidents saying they could worsen the situation. The bench declined to pass any interim order and said the matter would be heard in detail on Wednesday.

It however told senior advocates Mohit Mathur and Rakesh Khanna — representing various bar associations — that "you all are good, reputable lawyers and leaders" and asked them to see that the entire issue is resolved "properly". The lawyers, including Bar Council of India (BCI) chairman Manan Kumar

Mishra, told the court that it was in the process of resolving the entire issue and everything would have been normalised in a day or two, but senior police officers were making "provocative and threatening" statements on TV and Twitter. The bar associations have opposed the application, saying that police was seeking the relief to harass the lawyers. They also contended that videos were being circulated on social media to malign the image of the lawyers. The associations told the court that the entire legal fraternity cannot be held responsible for some stray incidents by persons who may or may not be lawyers.

The hearing took place hours after BCI came out with a statement asking various bar bodies to identify lawyers "indulging in hooliganism" and requested advocates to end their protests, which are "bringing bad name to the institution". They contended that police being a disciplined force was not expected to be issuing threats and making provocative statements. It said that the high court's order was "being construed to be a direction to mean that no coercive action in such incidents can be taken at all even in relation to the events and incidents subsequent to November 2". ■

Come what may, Delhi Police should take firm stand, says Kiran Bedi

Puducherry: Puducherry Lt. Governor Kiran Bedi on Tuesday advised Delhi Police to remain firm on its stand on Saturday's police-lawyers clash at Tis Hazari court come what may. Reacting to the incident, she told PTI that she faced a similar situation in January 1988 when a lawyer arrested for theft in St. Stephen's college was brought to the Tis Hazari court in handcuffs.

"But I remained firm and refused to budge to the demand of the lawyers seeking suspension/arrest of the cops re-

sponsible for hand cuffing the advocate," she said, adding that the person did not identify himself as an advocate at the time of his arrest and also gave a different name. In the present incident too, "Delhi Police should take a stand and be firm on it come what may", she said. Bedi, an ex-IPS officer of 1972 batch who retired in the rank of DGP said during the 1988 police-lawyers clashes at Tis Hazari, wherein she was DCP(North) then, there were demands from the advocates associations for her suspension and arrest. ■
